

A GUIDE TO LORD'S CRICKET GROUND

DRESS CODE IN THE PAVILION

A formal dress code applies in the Pavilion at all times.

- Gentlemen must wear a tailored jacket or blazer, a collared shirt, tailored trousers (chinos or corduroys are acceptable), a tie or cravat, formal shoes, and socks
- Ladies must wear tailored trousers, a skirt, dress, a smart top or blouse and formal shoes, boots, or sandals

DRESS CODE IN THE MEMBERS' FRIENDS' ENCLOSURES

A smart casual dress code applies for all in the Members' Friends' Enclosures.

Gentlemen aged over 16 must wear a collared shirt or top. Shorts and trousers must be tailored (denim is acceptable).

Middlesex replica playing shirts are an acceptable shirt to be worn.

MCC reserved the right to refuse entry to any person considered unsuitably attired into any Members' Friends' Enclosures or the Pavilion.

ALCOHOL POLICY

Alcohol may be brought into Lord's, in the following quantities (per person):

- Wine/Champagne – max 750ml
- Beer or Cider – max 2 cans/bottles of 500ml each
- Pre-mixed aperitifs – max 2 cans of 330ml each

JUNIORS AND TEEN MEMBERS

No unaccompanied Youth Member (young persons up to 18 years) will be admitted to the Pavilion.

No unaccompanied Youth Member may introduce a guest to the Pavilion or Members' Friends Enclosures.

No person under the age of 12 years will be admitted to the Pavilion on any match day.

Youth Members may purchase an adult Rover Ticket to be accompanied at Vitality Blast matches.

VITALITY BLAST - MEMBERS' SEATING AND MEMBERS' GUESTS TICKETS

Middlesex Members must sit in the Pavilion or Members' Friends' Enclosures, unless you have purchased a public ticket.

Members' Guests who have purchased a general public ticket will NOT be able to sit with Members in any Members' areas.

Middlesex Members wishing to bring Guests, must purchase either a Pavilion Admission ticket (max 1 per match) for their guest, which allows them to sit in the Pavilion, or a Rover Ticket (max 4 per match) for their guests, which allows them to sit in the Members' Friends' Enclosures.

Pavilion Admission Tickets allow access to the Pavilion and the Upper Allen Stand.

Rover Tickets allow access to the Tavern Stand and Warner Stand.

All seating in Members' areas is unallocated, so early arrival at the ground to take your seats is recommended.

Please note: Both Pavilion Admission and Rover Tickets are subject to availability and are limited in numbers, so purchasing early is recommended.

Youth Members are not able to purchase Pavilion Admission Tickets

SIGNING IN GUESTS FOR COUNTY CHAMPIONSHIP

Members (with the exception of youth members) may sign one Guest into the Pavilion and two Guests into the Members' Friends' Enclosures after payment of the ground admission charge.

Members' who have used their Season Guest Pass to bring a Guest to Lord's may also sign this Guest into the Pavilion or Members' Friends' Enclosures.

CAR PARKING

Parking is extremely limited at Lord's and cannot be guaranteed. Enquiries about accessible parking should be made to 0207 616 8500.

LATE GATE ADMISSION

At the start of the tea interval on the first three days of all County Championship matches, ground entry price will be reduced to half the adult admission price. Under normal circumstances, there is no late gate admission for one-day or Vitality Blast matches.

ACCESSIBLE VIEWING AREAS

Lord's has dedicated viewing facilities for members with disabilities. For details of the Lord's accessibility policy, please visit lords.org/accessibility

IMPORTANT OTHER INFORMATION

- If radios are in use in the ground, earpieces must be used
- No dogs, other than assistance dogs, are allowed in the ground
- Membership cards must carry photo identification. Members without photo ID on their cards will be declined admission to the Pavilion and Members' Friends' Enclosures and advised to visit the Middlesex office, where a photo can be taken and added to your card
- Membership cards are non-transferrable. The Club reserves the right to inspect

them at any time. If used by another person, this may result in suspension of membership (rule 11.1)

- Autograph & photograph hunting which interrupts or delays players or match officials while leaving or entering the field of play is prohibited

MEMBERS' MATCH-DAY PRIVILEGES

On production of a valid membership card, Members are entitled to:

1. County Championship matches

- a. Admission to Lord's, the Pavilion, Members' Friends' Enclosures, and the Middlesex Room
- b. The right to sign one Guest into the Pavilion and two in the Members' Friends' Enclosures
- c. Admission to all home matches at Middlesex's Out-ground venues
- d. At away matches, on payment of the ground admission charge, Members' may be entitled to admission to Members' areas, at the discretion of the home venue

2. Vitality Blast group matches

- a. Admission to Lord's, the Pavilion, Members' Friends' Enclosures, and the Middlesex Room
- b. The right to bring a Guest into the Pavilion if they are in possession of a Pavilion Admission Ticket
- c. The right to bring up to four Guests into the Members' Friends' Enclosures, and the Middlesex Room if they are in possession of Rover Tickets.

Should Middlesex qualify for the knock-out stages of the competition, Members will be notified of match-day privileges at the time.

MAJOR MATCH-DAY PRIVILEGES

Middlesex Members are afforded certain benefits by MCC at major matches, including entrance to the Members' Friends' Enclosures on the fifth day of Test matches on production of a valid membership card, after payment of the ground admission charge.

OTHER MATCHES AT LORD'S

Middlesex Members are permitted free of charge entry to all MCC matches played at Lord's in 2022, plus the following other fixtures:
